

3. Registration:

• All participants are requested to register mandatorily on the My Bharat portal under the mega event of Yuva Utsav before taking part in any of the events of Yuva Utsav 2024.

Competition-wise details guidelines:

A. EXHIBITION OF SCIENCE MELA- COMPETITIVE EVENT (BOTH GROUP AND INDIVIDUAL)

- 1. Maximum 05 participants allowed in a team under Group event.
- 2. These projects will focus on various fields including biotechnology, robotics, artificial intelligence, renewable energy, environmental conservation, healthcare technology, digital solutions, etc.
- 3. The winners (1st and 2nd) in each category (group and individual) at the district level will advance to the state-level competition.

B. YOUNG ARTISTS CONTEST- PAINTING:

- 1. Only paper for making paintings will be provided by the organizing committee. Rest all other materials required to be brought by the participants.
- 2. Paintings should be unique and should not be a copy.
- 3. The exact subject will be given on the spot.

C. YOUNG WRITERS CONTEST-POETRY:

- 1. Only paper will be provided by the organizing committee.
- 2. The poem should be unique and should not be a copy.
- 3. The exact subject will be given on the spot.

D. MOBILE PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST:

- 1. All participants have to bring their mobile phones for photography.
- 2. The best photograph clicked by each participant should be submitted to the judging panel.

- 3. Participants are allowed to use the free photo editing mobile app available on the internet.
- 4. The exact subject will be given on the spot.

E. DECLAMATION CONTEST:

- 1. The speech will be of **7 minutes duration (maximum)** in Hindi or English only. The time limit will be strictly enforced. A 30-second warning will be given.
- 2. Subject/ Theme: Panch Pran.

F. DISTRICT CULTURAL FESTIVAL- Group events

- Only group folk dance will be allowed in the district cultural festival.
- 2. Maximum 10 participants allowed in the group.
