An one day institutional sponsored National Seminar was held in Indira Gandhi Government College, Tezu on 3rd April 2025 with academic colour and gaiety focusing on the theme “UNIFORM CIVIL CODE : ISSUES AND CHALLENGES. The seminar was organized by the Department of Political science. Eminent scholars from different parts of the country participated in the seminar.

The seminar commenced with the welcome address by Dr. P. C. Swain, HoD (Political Science) and convener of the seminar who emphasized the importance of the seminar in the wake of 75 years of Indian constitution. Dr. Kangki Megu, Principal of the college and Chief Patron of the seminar, in his introductory remarks, highlighted the vastness and the multifaceted aspects Uniform Civil Code along with its challenges, especially in the context of customary law and indigenous traditions.
